- 1. Visit the SIMCOEDHUMANE Trailer or our website www.SimcoeDHumane.ca to see our volunteer postings. If there is a posting you are interested in, ask for your volunteer application package at the office.
- 2. Choose two people to be personal references (not immediate family) and have them fill out the personal reference forms included in the volunteer application package.
- 3. Return the completed forms to the office in a sealed envelope. Please write 'Volunteer Application' on the outside of the envelope. If the office is closed, you may email your copy to volunteers@SimcoeDHumane.ca or mail to 24 Grigg Drive, P.O. box 193 Simcoe, ON, N3Y 4L1
- 4. When you have your volunteer interview, the letter requesting the criminal record check will be signed.
- 5. Apply to the Ontario Provincial Police for a police record check. There is a form and letter with more information in the application package. There may be a cost for this service.
- 6. You will be added to our WhenToHelp.com Scheduler and will be asked to check it often. It is your responsibility to offer your help ... Please do not wait for an invitation to begin your volunteer experience with us.
- 7. Participate in the scheduled volunteer orientation and training sessions specific to your volunteer role. You will be notified by WhenToHelp.com for these dates. Please join us for these dates!
- 8. Start your new volunteer experience, making a huge difference in the community and helping ALL animals.
- 9. You will receive ongoing opportunities and feedback

This form must be delivered and picked up <u>in person</u> during regular business hours. Those living in Norfolk County should visit the OPP Detachment 548 Queensway West, Simcoe.

- Fill out the appropriate forms at the OPP office
- You will need to provide 2 pieces of identification (1 must be a photo ID) along with the form below
- Once the screening is complete and with acceptable identification verifying your identity you can pick up the search results at the OPP office
- Contact the SIMCOEDHUMANE once the record check has been obtained to continue with the volunteer process
